Housing Accommodations: Crowne Plaza & nearby hotels

Housing is provided at hotels that are within walking distance of the Conference Center. Housing is included in the cost of the conference and we make housing arrangements with the nearby hotels to negotiate the best rate. In order to keep conference rates affordable, housing rates are based on maximum occupancy of 4 per room. Registration will include sending your preferred room arrangements on the Housing Form. Based on this information we will assign your group to a hotel. *Please do not contact the hotels directly.*

Someone in my group has a special need for housing due to a physical handicap. What should I do?

We will do our very best to help accommodate whatever needs that individual may have. Remember, we can only help as much as you communicate with us. For that reason, please contact our office (303-715-3252) as early as possible to explain your need and note the person on your Housing Form.

Is there transportation to the Crowne Plaza if we are staying at one of the other hotels?

All the hotels used for housing for the conference are within a 10 to 15-minute walk from the Crowne Plaza. We are unable to provide transportation to and from the Crowne Plaza from nearby hotels. If you have any participants that cannot walk this distance, please let us know as soon as possible and we will try to accommodate your situation.

What about the bus driver?

Your bus driver can be accommodated at the same hotel as your group in a single room for \$250.00 total. Please let us know as soon as possible if you plan to bring a bus driver. Bus drivers do not attend the conference.

What meals are provided?

Breakfast will be provided at your hotel Saturday and Sunday mornings. Lunch and dinner are provided at the Crowne Plaza on Saturday. All other meals are on your own. There are many

choices of restaurants within walking distance of all the hotels. Most groups plan to eat at one of the surrounding restaurants on Friday afternoon before the conference begins. Group leaders often bring snacks for their teens who get hungry in the late evening after the conference ends on Friday and Saturday nights.

What do I do if I have a food allergy?

If you have a member in your group with a food allergy that we need to be aware of (lactose intolerant, wheat/peanut allergy, etc.), please let us know. There is a section that allows you to share this information with us on the Group Information Form. We will work with the Crowne Plaza to try to accommodate your needs; however, we recommend that you bring some safe foods, just in case.

What should I pack?

Each participant should bring clothing appropriate/comfortable for a church function and summer weather, his or her personal items, Bible, journal, and spending money (many participants like to get things from the Marketplace).

What is the weather like? How should I dress?

Denver is very warm during the summer. Water bottles will be provided as it is very important to drink plenty of water in Denver's altitude and hot, dry weather. We sometimes have afternoon thunderstorms. Dress to be casual, comfortable, and modest.
