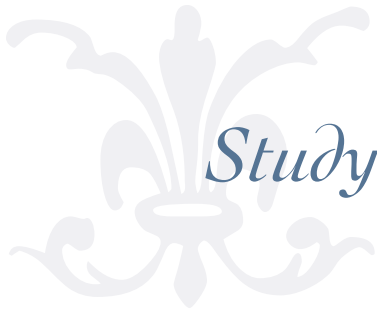

TOBET – Theology of the Body Evangelization Team

TOBET4ENGAGED examines practical topics through the lens of St. John Paul’s *Theology of the Body*. Couples develop familiarity with TOB themes and deepen their understanding of the “whys behind the whats” of the Catholic Church’s teaching on marriage and sexuality. Some common TOB themes include:

The Body Matters, is a teaching tool intended to assist primary educators (parents) in forming their children, and to be inserted into already-existing curricula at Catholic schools and parish faith formation programs.

While not addressing controversial issues directly, *The Body Matters Curriculum*, infused with St. John Paul’s theology, will restore the dignity of the human person and form families and their children in the truths of the Catholic faith, *precisely through a deeper understanding of the human BODY*.
