

## Steubenville of the Rockies Marketplace Code of Conduct

As part of our policy for protecting our youth, The Steubenville of the Rockies Conference adopts the following Exhibitor/Vendor Code of Conduct.

In connection with any level of sponsorship the exhibitor/vendor shall:

- Only assign staff that has a current background check which is acceptable.
- Exhibit the highest ethical standards and personal integrity.
- Conduct themselves in a professional manner, free from physical, psychological, emotional, written, or verbal intimidation or harassment.
- Avoid taking unfair advantage of any relationship for their own benefit.
- Not physically, sexually, or emotionally abuse or neglect minors or adults.
- Require their booth workers to share concerns about suspicious or inappropriate behavior with them and event organizer.
- Report any suspected abuse or neglect of a minor to local authorities.
- Accept personal responsibility to protect minors and adults from all forms of abuse.
- Limit their contact with conference participants to that which is appropriate to their role within that event.
- Exclude from work, staff who:
  - are being investigated for or have ever been convicted of a disqualifying offense.
  - have ever been terminated from employment or a volunteer position for reasons related to allegations of verbal, physical, or sexual abuse committed by them.
  - have sought or received any medical, physical, or psychological treatment for reasons involving verbal, physical or sexual abuse committed by them.
