Sample Announcement:

The key things are to communicate the following:

- 1) Be transparent about the topic –This is a 3 hour class that teaches caring adults about the prevention of and response to child sexual abuse. You can also direct people to What to Expect on the www.virtusonline.org home page to get more specific information about the content of the class.
- 2) Offer a way for people to reach out beforehand if they have concern about the topic (Contact OMAAP regarding alternative options for those potentially triggered by the content)
- 3) Emphasize the need for preregistration and provide links/QR for registration
- 4) Position as an invitation to be part of the mission of keeping the community safe
- 5) Note that this is a class for adults, and no minors are allowed (infants under 1 are the exception).
