## **Promoting the PGC Class**

The key things are to communicate the following and be cognizant of being trauma informed in promotions:

- 1) Be transparent about the topic –This is a 3 hour class that teaches caring adults about the prevention of and response to child sexual abuse. You can also direct people to <u>What to Expect</u> on the <u>www.virtusonline.org</u> home page to get more specific information about the content of the class.
- 2) Offer a contact for people to reach out beforehand with questions or concerns about the topic (Contact OMAAP regarding alternative options for those potentially triggered by the content)
- 3) Emphasize the need for preregistration and provide links/QR for registration
- 4) Position as an invitation to be part of the mission of keeping the community safe
- 5) Note that this is a class for adults, and no minors are allowed (infants under 1 are the exception).
- 6) Emphasize that late arrivals cannot be accommodated.
